

The Commitments of Parents in CP Academy *(finalized at parent meeting 02/16/06)*

Check the website regularly (<http://www.bhscpa.org>), to see if your child has HW and what your child's HW is.

Check twice a month with all of your child's teachers to make sure that your child is doing the HW.

If you are having problems with your child's education ask for help immediately.

Make sure your child eats a healthy breakfast and gets enough sleep.

Make sure your child is prepared for school (clothes, utensils, etc.).

Attend at least one BHS open house per year.

Attend at least five CP Academy parent council meetings per year.

Attend the annual CP Academy student exhibition at the end of the year.

Volunteer for CP Academy a minimum of ten hours per year.

Reward your child if there is significant improvement in academic performance.

Make a four-year plan for your child.

Talk to your child's counselor at least once a year.

Talk to the college advisor at least once while your child is at BHS.

Attend a College/Career Center program at least twice a year (see BHS website, <http://www.bhs.berkeley.k12.ca.us/services/collegecenter.html>).

Actively participate in community service and service-learning projects.

Support positive community development through respectful words and actions.
